This proposed ordinance grants some authority to the building inspector to issue certificates of appropriateness. City Clerk Stamm explained also some of dysfunctional problems with the current process. Doctor David Riese made comments. It may currently take a month for someone to get a certificate of appropriateness approved. This will speed up the process in some instances. More discussion took place.
