They stated that they make the applicants for adoption fill out a form stating how many animals they have and they also check with the veterinarians and then refuse adoption if they are over the limits. Questions and discussion took place. Aldersperson Henke said to write another ordinance would cost the city quite a bit of money. The Humane Society wants more than 3 cats per household to be allowed, but to maintain the 6 dog & cat limit per household. Chief Kelley said they get just as many complaints about cats as about dogs and we will be going backwards if we change now. More questions and discussion took place. Aldersperson Hunter motioned to leave the ordinance as is. More brief discussion took place. Aldersperson Hannes seconded the motion. Motion carried.
